

**DAY 01: IQUITOS – CAPINURÍ LODGE** 

- Pick up from the airport according to the schedule of your flight or your hotel in the city of Iquitos.
- NANAY. Transfer to the Bellavista Nanay Tourist Pier, during the tour you will be given a brief orientation through the city of Iquitos, observing the main tourist places of this thriving and historic city in eastern Peru that in the 19th century became a small town. further. important river port in the Amazon.

  Arrival at the Bellavista Nanay Tourist Pier, where we will take a tour of approximately 10 to 15 minutes, before getting on the boat and learning a little about the gastronomy of the jungle, here we can appreciate the typical dishes of the area and taste them if you wish. Next we begin navigation along the largest river in the world and one of the 7 Natural Wonders of the World, the Amazon River, aboard comfortable and safe typical boats. The trip along the Amazon River will allow you to appreciate a wonderful panorama in which the magnificence of the river makes its way through the exuberance of the jungle, travel time approximately 1:30 hrs.

  As the first stop during our navigation we will stop to appreciate the union of the Amazon and Nanay rivers and see the change in the color of the waters.
- **CAPINURI LODGE**. We will arrive at the lodge where there will be a short explanation about the rules that govern the sustainability of the lodge and its environment, allowing you to better understand the ways to make your stay more rewarding.
- MONKEY ISLAND. Continuing our navigation through the Amazon, we will enter a ravine to visit the monkeys in their natural habitat, upon arrival we will be greeted by the different ones: Woolly monkey, titi monkey, spider monkey or maquisapa. ), among other species of monkeys that live in this place where we can learn from each one of them, feed them, play and take photos with them and all in their natural habitat!!
- **SPOTTING OF GRAY OR PINK DOLPHINS DURING THE JOURNEY**
- PIRANHA FISHING After that activity we get ready to undertake the Artisanal Fishing tour, here the guide will guide us on the local fishing techniques for piranhas or other species with the same material that the man of the jungle uses for subsistence purposes. (We can taste the fish)
- 🖶 LUNCH
- **BATHING IN THE AMAZON RIVER** After having appreciated the beautiful fauna within the reserve, we got ready to then head to enjoy the fresh waters of the Amazon River and swim very close to the pink dolphins.
- **DINNER**
- NIGHT EXCURSION. Your guide will tell you when the walking tour will begin that will take you to discover the mysterious world of nocturnal insects, cicadas, spiders, praying mantises, snakes, giant toads, among others.

- **AMAZON SUNRISE.** Observation of this and exotic birds: During the early hours of the morning, it is the right time to observe many of the species of birds that feed on the banks of the river, as well as see the majestic sunrise at the national reserve that gives way to a new day.
- BREAKFAST AT THE BASE CAMP
- SANTA MARIA DE FATIMA. After breakfast we will prepare for our trip to the Santa María de Fátima community, a small town of approximately 200 people near the Amazon River. They develop an ecotourism project and built a 15-meter wooden tower, in the middle of the jungle, to enjoy the landscape and observe different species of birds in El Garzal. Navigation on the Amazon River towards Santa María de Fátima. Approximately 30 minutes of motorboat travel.
- **JUNGLE EXCURSION.** We get ready to take a botanical walk to learn about the main trees and medicinal plants that exist in the Amazon, many of them with healing properties and others with certain mysticisms, our guide will explain each of them to us until we reach the heron.
- VIEWER. We will climb the 3-story wooden tower (15 meters) to enjoy the landscape and observe birds and animals.
- fruits to keep us energized. We will carry out a canoe expedition, advancing slowly through the dense vegetation of El Garzal. Here we can find the Shansho (Hoatzin), a prehistoric Amazonian bird, and different species of herons such as the snowy egrett, the white boat billed heron, the brown boat billed heron, among other. During the day we will eat fruits to stay energized
- ➡ NIGHT NAVIGATION We will navigate the Pucate River, we will go out in a canoe to go in search of alligators for observation and we will learn about the life of each of these species and their main role in nature, we will also observe fireflies, and enjoy the night sound of the Amazon jungle

# **DIA 03: YANAYACU RESERVE**

## BREAKFAST

- **CAMPING (OPTIONAL)** We will pack our camping equipment and walk to the San Juan de Huashalado community. From there we will begin our boat trip to the Yanayacu River basin. We will tour this beautiful ecosystem and immerse ourselves in the "Jungle of Mirrors" (named after the clear reflection of the water). We will take a walk in the "Kingdom of Giant Trees", and if we stay attentive and observe carefully and patiently, we will be able to observe some animals in their natural habitat such as sloths, monkeys, lizards and birds. Here we will also observe the Lupuna (ceiba pentandra), the largest tree species in the Amazon rainforest.
- **LUNCH ON BOARD**
- **JUNGLE EXCURSION ON SECONDARY JUNGLE.** Walk in the jungle for approximately 1 hour and a half, going deeper and heading towards the Yahua cocha lagoon. Along the way we will be able to see different species of monkeys in the trees around us.
- GIANT TREE OF THE AMAZON. Our goal is to reach the giant tree where we can make our wish to Mother Nature under the feet of the Lupuna tree. Where we will hug the tree and also where nature will transmit pure energy to us and we will emerge renewed. We can also swing on the beautiful vines that come down from the giant tree and have a little fun before returning to the Lodge.
- **CANOE EXPLORATION**. We will explore by canoe, enjoying the landscape and observing birds such as herons, tibes, among others. In Yahua cocha we can try our luck fishing, if you wish. Here we can find Acarahuazu (Oscar fish), Fasaco (Common trahira), Tucunare (Peacock cichlid), among others.

- **ARTISAN FISHING IN THE RESERVE** It will be time to put into practice what you learned about fishing during the first days. We will go artisanal fishing. The guide will teach you and assist you with some local fishing techniques
- **LUNCH**
- At the appropriate time, we will take our boat to go to Iquitos
- Arrival in Nanay and transfers to the city center
